History of the Faculty of Humanities

The Faculty of Humanities was established on 17 June 1981. It marked the 11th faculty of Kasetsart University. According to University Announcement regarding the division of government agencies of Kasetsart University, B.E. 2524 (1981), the Faculty of Humanities was designated as one of the 17 government agencies affiliated with Kasetsart University.

1981

The Faculty of Humanities acquired the transfer of the Department of Languages from the Faculty of Science and Arts. Subsequently, this Department was divided into three distinct departments: the Department of Languages, the Department of Linguistics, and the Department of Literature. Furthermore, the Faculty received the Department of Philosophy and Religion from the Faculty of Social Sciences and simultaneously founded three new departments: the Department of Library Science, the Department of Arts and Crafts, and the Department of Communication Arts, bringing the total to seven departments.

1993

The Language Center was founded as an internal institution to provide foreign language training services for the general public.

1994

The Department of Languages were divided into two departments: the Department of Foreign Languages and the Department of Thai Language. This brought the total number of departments in the Faculty to eight.

2006

The Confucian Institute was established following the collaboration of four organizations including the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, Huachiew University of the People's Republic of China, Kasetsart University, and the Faculty of Humanities. This institute was dedicated to teaching and researching the Chinese language and culture and served as the standardized test center for the Chinese proficiency exam known as "HSK" (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi).

Kasetsart University Council approved the establishment of Center for Special Education Management of the Faculty of Humanities to act as a service coordinator for the Faculty's special programs. This center delivered administrative and academic support for both undergraduate and graduate programs across special programs within all academic disciplines of the Faculty.

2009

The Department of Library Science was merged into Mass Communication Program of the Department of Communication Arts. Subsequently, it was renamed to the Department of Communication Arts and Information Science. Furthermore, the Faculty undertook a restructuring of the Music Program within the Department of Communication Arts, leading to the establishment of the Department of Music. Despite these changes, the total number of departments within the Faculty remained at eight.

2010

Faculty of Humanties acquired the transfer of Rajanagarindra Institute of Linguistics and Cultural Studies from Kasetsart University as a part of the supporting institutions, increasing the number of such institutions to five.

2012

The Japanese and Chinese Programs were separated from the Department of Foreign Languages to establish the Department of Eastern Languages. This new department not only facilitated education for Japanese and Chinese majors but also introduced elective courses in Korean and various Asian languages, such as Vietnamese, Malay, and Burmese, in anticipation of engagement with the ASEAN Community. Consequently, the total number of departments reached nine.

2014

The Faculty received the transfer of the Office of Agricultural Museum and Culture as a supporting agency dedicated to the preservation of arts and cultures under Rajanagarindra Institute of Linguistics and Cultural Studies. Additionally, it established the Language Testing Center of Kasetsart University to provide academic services related to language proficiency examinations, increasing the total number of supporting institutions to six.

2018

The Department of Arts and Crafts was renamed to the Department of Tourism and Hospitality Industry to align with contemporary trends of modernization and internationalization.

2020

Kasetsart University Council approved the restructure of projects within the Faculty to ensure efficient, transparent, and adaptable operations that are consistent with the demands of the modern world as follows.

The Faculty changed the names of subdivisions withing the Office of the Secretary including "Academic Services Subivision" to "Academic Administration Subdivision" and "Building, Physical Plant, and Vehicles Subdivision" to "Physical Resources Subdivision".

The Faculty streamlined divisions within Rajanagarindra Institute of Linguistics and Cultural Studies from two to one subdivision and named it as the Cultural Promotion and Innovation Subdivision. It consisted of two units: Agricultural Museum and Center for Innovative Music and Tourism.

The Faculty reclassified the status of Center for Special Education Management, previously holding a departmental status, as the Special Education Management Unit. This Unit operated under the Academic Administration Subdivision, Office of Secretary.

2022

The Faculty adjusted the internal management structures to warrant clear, efficient, and adaptable operations which align with the demands of the modern world, as outlined below.

The Office of Secretary was divided into five subdivisions.

- 1.Administration and General Services Subdivision
- 2.Finance and Supply Subdivision 3.Academic Administration Subdivision
- 4.Planning and Quality Assurance Subdivision
- 5. Physical Resources Subdivision

Center for Innovative Music and Tourism, previously considered equivalent to a unit within the Cultural Promotion and Innovation Subdivision under the Rajanagarindra Institute of Linguistics and Cultural Studies, underwent restructuring. It was transferred to the Department of Music and had been renamed as "Center for Music Learning."

The Faculty founded "Center for Lifelong Learning" as a part of the proactive plan initiated by the Dean.

Applicants must complete Mathayom 6 or equivalent or hold a vocational certificate from military music school. Moreover, applicants must not have prohibited characteristics according to Kasetsart University Regulations on Kasetsart University Undergraduate Studies B.E. 2566 (2023).

Additional Qualifications:

Applicants must be able to demonstrate proficiency in playing at least one western music instrument, specifically in the domains of symphony, orchestra, classical guitar, classical piano, or classical singing. Admission is not available for those specializing in harp, recorder, electric keyboard, electric guitar, or any other electric musical instruments.




